



Bennar Site Rules

This bit is to ensure everyone's stay at Bennar is happy and safe

Check-in after: 13:00 pm

Check-out before: 11:00 am

Noise and behaviour

Site Management ("We") ask that you respect the peaceful nature of our site and do not disturb other campers. Keep voices low and music off after 10 pm. You will be asked to leave if noise levels are disturbing others. Don't fly drones, use a generator or keep an engine running. No fireworks or similar. No climbing on the walls. Please see the "Site Management Rights" section below.

Bins, Recycling, Cleaning

Guide notes are provided for waste types on each bin, please help Wales to recycle as much as possible. No bulky packaging or broken camping gear to be disposed of on site. When it's time to go home please leave no trace of your stay in the camping field.

Chemical Toilets

Please only empty chemical toilets at the Elsan point, which is behind the main bathroom block

BBQ and Fire Precautions

No smoking is permitted by showers or buildings.

We allow fire pits as long as they are raised off the ground and do not scorch the grass. Only dispose of BBQ/ASH once its completely cold to the touch in the metal bin marked "Ash"

Dogs

Dogs must be kept on a short lead and supervised at all times so that they are not a nuisance or danger to other people or other pets. Whilst at your pitch please keep dogs within the pitch boundary. Maximum of three dogs per pitch.

Pitching

All pitches will be allocated prior to arrival. A map showing site layout and pitch location will be emailed to you a couple of days before your arrival. Please ensure that you use the allocated pitch number.

All pitches are 9m x 9m. Your complete setup must fit within the pitch boundary. All Pitches are numbered. Please use your pitch number as a central point when setting up your camp. As per fire regulations, please leave a 1.5m gap between you and your pitch boundary. This will ensure that you remain a safe distance of 3m from your neighbour.

Please seek advice from a member of staff regarding second vehicles.

All pitches must be cleared of any shells/stones/wood ect prior to departure.

Speed Limit and vehicles

Limit speed to 5 mph, avoid movement of vehicles between 11pm and 8am

Electric Vehicle Charging

For safety reasons and to protect our electrical system, please don't use standard 3-pin sockets or portable charging devices (like "granny chargers" or In-Cable Control Boxes) to charge electric vehicles on site.

We know it might be convenient, but these methods aren't designed for our setup and could cause safety issues.

Cancellation Policy

Free cancellation and refund up to one month before your arrival date, less the booking fee.

Changes to your booking (not cancellation)

Site Management are not obliged to make any changes to your booking.

Site Management Rights

We reserve the right to cancel the remaining booking of any guests who cause complaints from other guests, or if anyone does not respect the rules of the site, the Site Manager and their team reserve the right to refuse you admission or ask you to leave the site at any time. If you are asked to leave under these circumstances, no monies will be refunded. Additionally the Site Manager and the team reserve the right to refuse future admission to the Site should they deem (at their sole discretion) that your conduct was in breach of any of the Site Rules.
